UKOPRA PERFORMANCE INDEX CHAMPIONSHIP 2019



Description

During the winter of 2018 the committee have worked to provide a performance index for each class with the purpose of creating an overall award regardless of class of boat raced.

The calculation of indexes is based on historic information that gives an expected performance for the given class against which the team performance is assured on the day.

The index allows for a number of manners of racing against each other which could be specific course lengths set for individual classes, adjusted elapsed times, adjusted elapsed distances, adjusted speeds dependant on the suitability for each race.

Methods of index adjustment and index applied will be published in each case one week after the race instructions for the event are created and take the form of race bulletin.

Award status

The management of the index championship is to be undertaken by three UKOPRA committee members chaired by John Guille and being their award to determine will be full and final with no protest accepted.

The award is made to the team.

The team may nominate team member changes at any point during the season.

At first attendance the team must nominate the country they represent for which one of their team members must hold residence.

The team may change their boat due to irreparable damage once only within the championship and must declare that change within 7 days of the damage occurring.

Trophies

Race awards will be at the discretion of the individual race organiser.

Positions to third place will be awarded.

Final award of the Performance Index Championship will take place at an awards ceremony to be held.
